METHOD OF RACING - ALL CLASSES EXCEPT FIOO

Heats 1 & 2 - 10 Laps, Pre-final - 14 Laps, Final - 16 Laps.

Pre-drawn grid for 1st Heat. Reverse grid for 2nd Heat

Combined points from heats determines gird position of pre final Finishing order of pre final determines grid position for the final

Final only counts on the day.

METHOD OF RACING -F100

Timed Practice 1 x 4mins

Heat 1 & 2 -10 Laps Pre-Final -14 Laps Final -16 Laps

Fastest 'Timed Practice' lap time recorded to grid 1 and so on for heats 1 & 2 Combined points from heats determines the grid position for pre-final. Finishing order of the Pre-final determines the grid position for the final.

Final only counts on the day

Prizes Trophies awarded to 1st, 2nd and 3rd placegetters.

ALL STAR SERIES Prize Pool is to be combined over series and awarded to $1^{\rm st}$ $2^{\rm nd}$ & 3rd placegetters at completion of the series. All prizes, prize money, will be awarded at the VKA Presentation Night in December 2008 – date and venue TBA

Blue and Red Double Diagonal flag will be used during this meeting.





Scrutineering

- ▶ All Karts must be Scrutineered before taking part in Timed Practice.
- ▶ Cylinder head and exhaust sealing nuts are required.
- ▶ Correctly fitted Transponder Holder to suit AMB TranX 160 timing system is required Transponder holders will be available on the day at a cost of \$10 each.

Pitting / Passes / Sealing Tags / Security / Canteen

Pit passes and sealing tags will be issued at Confirmation of Entry. Pitting from trailers or vehicles will be limited and restricted to designated areas only. **Security will be provided Friday and Saturday evenings.**

Canteen will be open Friday, Saturday & Sunday with <u>breakfast available on Saturday & Sunday.</u>

PLEASE NOTE:

- Parking of motor vehicles is not permitted in the designated pit area.
- · Smoking or welding is not allowed in the designated pit area.
- Dumping of Fuel is only permitted in drums provided.
- Animals are not allowed
- No riding of scooters or bikes permitted.
- Camping is not permitted.
- Hire Marquees are not to be erected without the knowledge & approval of the GKCV
- It is a condition of entry to display sponsor decals on karts as directed by the promoter.
- Lost or damaged transponders will be the responsibility of the driver and / or entrant and will charged by the Geelong Kart Club for the cost of repair and / or replacement

The promoters reserve the right at their sole discretion to refuse entry, or alter, abandon, combine, postpone or cancel any event as per the 2008 AKA Manual and published Amendments.
