Series Information



The Championship will be run over 4 rounds at the Phillip Island Grand Prix Circuit and Winton Motor Raceway in conjunction with the 2010 VSKC Club Championships. It is open to all Junior competitors aged between 12 & 16 who have not previously held a CAMS circuit racing licence and will be run under a CAMS permit.

The winning driver will be recognized as the "Victorian Junior State Champion" and will receive a fully funded trip to the AMSF AIS Motorsport Camp in 2011. In addition MINDA Motor Sport has offered in conjunction with the AMSF to provide a "free" test drive in a CAMS Rising Star Formula Ford race car for the winner of the series.

The cost to each competitor will be \$799.00:

What the VSKC provides for entrants:

- CAMS licence (12 months)
- 12 months membership to VSKC
- One set Dunlop tyres
- Entry to 4 rounds of racing
- Polo shirt & cap
- Championship kart decal kit
- Transponder bracket
- Tyre bag with numbered seal
- Sponsors showbag (filled with useful race items from various sponsors)
- Communal garage at each round.

Trophies will be awarded for 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, & 5th place.

What the Entrants must provide themselves:

- CAMS medical
- Approved rain light (see CAMS regulations)
- Approved race apparel
- Organize CAMS logbook inspection (check with club for Logbook Scrutineering Day)

Dates for the Junior Championship will be:

Saturday May 15 at Phillip Island

Saturday July 17 at Phillip Island

Sunday September 12 at Winton Motor Raceway

Saturday November 13 at Phillip Island



Series Rules

- Jetting will be restricted to 4 controlled jets. (To be selected on the day)
- Gearing will be restricted to 3 controlled sprockets. (To be selected on the day). Front sprocket must be a 16 tooth.
- Each competitor will be restricted to **one** set of Dunlop SL6 tyres (1 set for 4 rounds) that will be supplied as part of the championship. All tyres will be marked at round one.
At the end of each race day the competitors set of tyres must be removed from the rims and sealed in a named tyre bag. The VSKC will hold all tyres between rounds.
If the race meeting is "WET", Dunlop wet tyres will be available at the track for purchase by the entrant on the day.
- All karts must run Sprint (CIK) plastics, no extra body work and no mirrors.
- Each kart must be fitted with an approved rain light , refer to CAMS Superkart Technical regs #2.9- Hella Dura LED- part no 2307.)
- Each kart must run a Junior Rotax engine with a 2010 barrel.
- Each competitor will receive 4 sets of kart Sponsor decals to be run at each meeting.

Other Information:

- Junior Championship will be run in conjunction with the VSKC Club Championship series held at Phillip Island GP Circuit & Winton Raceway
- Races will be combined with the Club race format and will come under the VSKC 2010 sporting regulations.
- 2010 CAMS technical regulations will be used.
- Garages will be supplied for all competitors to pit together for the Championship rounds.
- The services of a qualified mentor will be available to all competitors if required.
- Juniors must be between the age of 12 and 16 to compete and have not previously held a CAMS licence.
- All competitors must obtain their own Cams kart Logbook and approved race apparel.
- The VSKC will assist the drivers with licences, logbooks and correct apparel.
- Drivers must be over 14 to take the Formula Ford test drive. (in 2011)
- Once a competitor has registered for the series, further forms, (including licensing and logbook forms) will be forwarded to you)
