7 .Minimum Entries

The minimum number of entries per class shall be 8. If insufficient entries are received for a class, classes will be cancelled or combined at the discretion of the Organizers.

8. Format of Racing

2 x 6 minute practice sessions Sat Morning from 9.00 am

- 1 x 10 lap heat Saturday afternoon.
- 1 x 10 lap heat Sunday morning.
- 1 x 12 lap pre final
- 1 x 16 lap final (final only counts)

Starting positions for heat 1 and heat 2 will be random draw. Points system 401 less 10%. Total points for heats combined gives starting position for pre final. Finishing position in pre final gives starting position for final. Final only counts for result of the round. All points for all races count towards overall series result.
