3. Classes to Compete

4. Entries

The fee for entry in each class shall be \$80.00 per driver.

Both Drivers

MUST enter via CM:S, second driver to enter as same race number followed by the letter S (eg 24S)

Must complete Scrutineering forms and confirm entry at Entry Confirmation. <u>Pre Entry on CM:S.</u>

Payment may be made when entering through CM:S. Click on 'Payment Option' and select preferred method of payment.

Payment will also be accepted at Entry Confirmation – by cash, cheque, credit card or EFTPOS. The Barter System will not be in use for payment of entry fee for this event.

<u>Postal Entry</u> Mail entries with cheque can also be sent to. Race Secretary, C/- 25 Carmela Way Carrum Downs Only entries received on the Official Karting Australia Entry form will be accepted.

The date and time for close of entry shall be: Bedtime on Wednesday 12th Nov 2014.

5. Minimum Entries

The minimum number of entries per class shall be 10. If insufficient entries are received for a class, classes will be cancelled or combined at the discretion of the Organizer.

6. Format of Racing

Tag & Tag over 40's	1 x 2.5 hour race 2 Drivers

Grid positions determined by practice times

Trophies will be awarded to $\mathbf{1^{st}},\,\mathbf{2^{nd}}$ and $\mathbf{3^{rd}}$ place getters

 $\mathbf{1}^{st}$ place goes to the team that has completed most laps.

 2^{nd} place to the team with the next completed most laps.

3rd place to the team with the next completes most laps.

<u>8. Fuel</u>

All classes must use commercially produced PULP fuel as per 2014 Karting Australia manual

Re-fuelling & chain lubrication can only be carried out and in designated area. Junior Performance kart fuel tank maximum 9 litres.

Scrutineering: will be conducted throughout the race meeting.

Exhaust Sealing nuts must be fitted for Sportsman Restricted Class, Exhaust restrictors will be checked & sealed at the completion of timed practice.

9. Pit Stops

Teams/Drivers can *quick* stop whenever they wish to. There are no maximum number of stops for *quick* stops (chain lube etc.)

Re-fuelling & chain lubrication can only be carried out and in designated area. Junior drivers fuel tank maximum 9 litre

Junior Performance drivers must have minimum 1 compulsory pit stop, for a minimum of 5 minutes for refueling and repairs. Timing will start when each kart enters

the in-grid pit lane. All karts must have engines switched off until time is up. Please note; the timing system will be counting DOWN from 1.30hrs to 0.00hrs. Each karts compulsory pit stop times will be manually recorded by time keepers at in-grid / out-grid and times marked on official sticker to be placed on Nassau panel, all karts should complete the race with stickers attached showing their 1 pit stops. Compulsory stop must be completed by 1 hours 30 minutes. (excluding quick stops)

TaG and Sportsman Restricted drivers must have 2 compulsory pit stops, each lasting a minimum of 10 minutes for fuel, brake pads, drive line repairs, driver rehydration etc. Timing will start when each kart enters the in-grid pit lane. All karts must have engines switched off until time is up. Please note; the timing system will be counting DOWN from 2.30hrs to 0.00hrs. Each karts compulsory pit stop times will be manually recorded by time keepers at in-grid / out-grid and times marked on official sticker to be placed on Nassau panel, all karts should complete the race with stickers attached showing their 2 pit stops. All 2 compulsory stops must be completed by 2 hours 30 minutes. (excluding quick stops)

Any Kart to be found under nominated weight will incur a 5 minute extra time penalty.

Drivers : Junior Performance - Each driver must complete a minimum of 30 minutes in each driver stint.

TaG & Sportsman – Each Driver must complete a minimum of 60 minutes total driver time.

Monitoring and recording of Driver times and driver changes will be controlled time keepers and assistants.

10. Safety Car

In the event of a kart losing a chain or breaking down in any manner, a safety car will be brought out for crews to safely pick-up karts on a trolley to bring back to the pits. The yellow flag/light will be displayed as well as a board with SC to denote a "Safety Car" as distinct from an incident for drivers, and racing will continue when karts and people are off the track. The Safety Car will be brought out at the discretion for the Race Controller. The Pit Lane will be **CLOSED** until safety car picks up race leader. (**This will be indicated by Race Control**). There will no passing while safety car has been deployed until Green flag is shown at start finish line.

Karts cannot exit pit lane if safety car has entered turn 6.

8. <u>Mechanical Breakdown Lane</u> - A mechanical breakdown lane will be in use.

9. Abandonment or Postponement

The organizers reserve the right at their sole discretion to abandon, postpone or cancel any event(s) subject to Rule 1.25.

10. <u>**Insurance**</u> - Insurance has been affected for this meeting in accordance with Chapter 3.

11. Judges of Fact - refer to 2014 Karting Australia Manual

12. <u>**Transponders.**</u> - The use of a personal transponder will be mandatory for each kart.

13. <u>Clear Visor</u>

All TAG and TAG over 40 competitors must have clear visors fitted.

All drivers are required to have clear visors once the Track Flood Lights are turned on.

Background Note:

Article 65 of the International Sporting Code of the FIA, under which all competitions will be conducted sets out the information that should be included in the Supplementary Regulations. These Supplementary Regulations are to be read in conjunction with the General Standings Regulations and Australian Kart Formula for Sprint Racing as laid down in the current KA Manual and any addendums to the KA Manual.
