5. Classes to Compete

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6. Entry

The fee for entry in each event shall be \$190.00.

The date and time for close of entry shall be 5.00pm Tuesday 28th June 2011.

Drivers must hold a current AKA licence, Minimum licence requirement is Grade C. Pre-entries will be accepted online on the AKA CMS System.

By submitting an entry to race at the Closed State Titles you acknowledge that you have competed at a NSW (AKA) club for a minimum of 3 race meetings since July 2010 and have scored a minimum of 50 points in the North/South Series or 70 points in the Metropolitan Series in the State Cup.

7. Minimum Entries

The minimum number of entries per class shall be **(8)** *Eight.* If insufficient entries are received for a class, classes may be cancelled or combined at the discretion of the Organiser.

8. Format of Racing

Racing format will be as per rule 18.01 and 18.02 for over-subscribed classes

2 x 4 minute Qualifying Sessions, 2 Heats, Pre-Final and Final.

Grid positions for heats shall be determined by qualifying times, fastest times to the grid 1 and so on. Grid positions for the pre-final shall be determined by the lowest points accumulated in the heat races to grid 1, second lowest grid 2 & so on. In the case of a tie at the conclusion, the lower grid position will be awarded to the driver with the faster original timed qualifying. The final grid position will be determined by the finishing position in the pre-final.

Finishing order of the final determines the winning positions in each class.

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<u>Laps</u>

The number of laps shall be as follows: Heats 10 laps, pre-final 12 laps, final 15 Laps.

Points

Points allocation for all heats, shall be 1^{st} place = 0, 2^{nd} place = 2 points, 3^{rd} place = 3 points etc. Non-starters and non-finishers to be awarded a finishing position based on the number of laps completed, then the grid position awarded from the start of the heat.

10. Mechanical Breakdown Lane

The mechanical breakdown lane will not be in use as per rule 17.10

11. Blue and Red Double Diagonal Flag

The blue and red double diagonal flag will be used in the final only. (Rule 15.13)

12. Abandonment or Postponement

The Organisers have the right at their sole discretion to abandon, postpone or cancel any event(s) subject to Rule 1.25.

13. Awards

First, second and third place getters in each class will be presented with prizes and / or trophies.

14. Insurance

Insurance has been affected for this meeting in accordance with Chapter 3 2011 AKA Manual

15. Noise Levels

Maximum permissible noise levels shall be in accordance with Chapter 24 2011 AKA Manual

16. Fuel (Refer Chapter 22)

The only fuels to be used at this meeting will be Mobil 98 Premium Unleaded, and must be purchased from Top Town Mobil, 477 Banna Ave Griffith. Refer Rule 22.03.7.

Fuel must be purchased between Thursday 7th and Sunday 10th July 2011 inclusive, from either bowsers 2, 5 or 6.

Random samples of competitor's fuel may be taken during the meeting and tested for conformity to samples taken from the supplier on these dates.

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Competitors are reminded that fuel tanks and drums should be empty prior to being used for fuel purchased for this meeting.

17. Judges of Fact

The Starter The Chief Lap scorer The Chief Timing Officer The Chief Scrutineer The Weigh Marshal The Noise Control Marshal The Grid Marshal (These will be as per Rule 4.17)

18. Weighing of Karts

Karts may be weighed at the conclusion of each event at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course or the Weigh Marshall. Should a competitor fail the first test they may request one additional test.

19. Historic Kart Demonstrations

A Historic Kart track demonstration *will not* be conducted at this meeting per Chapter 53.

20. Footwear

Covered footwear MUST be worn in the Paddock/Parc Ferme, In-grid and Out-grid.

21. Pit Crew Passes

All pit crew entering restricted areas (The Outgrid, The Ingrid, Parc ferme and Track) must have a current Pit Crew Pass per rule 11.06, and must wear a Fluro Jacket / Vest. Entry will be denied if correct pass is not produced.

22. Camping at the Track

Limited camping sites are available outside of the pit area on Wednesday to Saturday night. These must be pre-booked with the club. Toilet and Hot Shower facilities are available; however you must bring your own generator.

23. Conduct

The removal of both hands from the steering wheel or both feet from the pedals will result in the driver being penalised.

24. Transponders

Each competitor must have a transponder as per rule 16.05. Transponders must be fitted as per rule 16.05(b).
